2. Sign the Boat Registration Form (REQUIRED with NO EXCEPTIONS)
3. Provide a copy of Proof of Insurance
4. Send Payment required for 2009 Boat Registration Fee
5. Have account in good standing

Upon successfully registering, the Club issued identification shall be permanently affixed to the front left side of the watercraft and to a visible location on or near the tongue of the trailer. **False registration of non-Property Owner boats as Property Owner boats may result in fines and/or suspension of lake privileges.**
