WATERCRAFT RULES

Boating season here has arrived. As a reminder, some of the commonly forgotten rules of safe boating on the Lake Arrowhead lakes are listed here. Please see "Rules and Regulations, May 2008" (available at www.LakeArrowheadGA.com) for complete detailed information.

Only registered watercraft displaying current Lake Arrowhead registration decals are permitted on the Lake Arrowhead Lakes.

All watercraft operating in the northern part of Lake Arrowhead, as well as other areas designated with NO WAKE buoys must use a speed that generates no significant wake in the water and NEVER exceeds the speed of a brisk walk (less than 5 mph).

The body of water viewed from the Clubhouse area (the main lake) is an all sports area. All motorized watercraft are to follow a COUNTERCLOCKWISE direction.

Boat traffic will only cross-over at the Clubhouse or at either end of the lake.

No power boats may be operated within fifty (50) feet of swim areas.

No drinking of alcoholic beverages is permitted when operating watercraft.

All ski boats must have an observer to assist the driver. The number of persons towed is limited to two (2) per boat at the same time.

All watercraft must use running lights before dawn and after sundown.

Swimming is not permitted in the area of any dams on the lakes. All children, below a responsible age, swimming in the lakes, must wear a life vest and be supervised by an adult 18 years of age or older.

Personal watercraft (i.e. Jet Skis, Wave Runners and SeaDoos) are PROHIBITED.

Parking at the "Narrows Marina" is to be used by slip renters only. Overflow parking for Narrows residents and guests should be at Great Festival park.

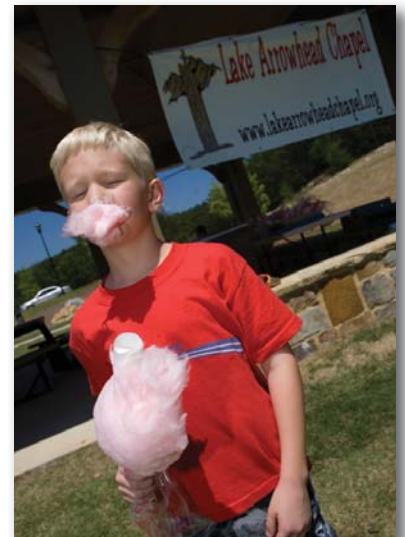
